Census Day -

Start of Day

If you have a message for your child's teacher, this should be given to one of the adults on the gate to pass on.

End of Day

School ends at 3:15pm for all children. Gates will open at 3:10pm and close promptly at 3:20pm. Parents should come onto the playground to collect their child(ren) from the class teachers.
