Happy New Year! We hope you all had a fantastic Christmas break and that all the children are now ready for a busy start to the Spring term. We have lots of exciting topics and learning planned for the whole class and the year 6 will start to build towards this year's SATS.

Our termly project will be geography based - 'Our changing world'

This term we will learn about features of the Earth, time zones and lines of latitude and longitude to pinpoint places on a map. We will then find out more about map scales, grid references, contour lines and map symbols. We will learn about climate change and the importance of global trade, study patterns of human settlements and carry out an enquiry to describe local settlement patterns.

Literacy

Our Literacy topics this term will be monologues, persuasive letters and poetry. You can support your child with daily reading and regularly practicing their spellings on Spelling Shed.

Maths

Our maths topics for the next 6 weeks will be 'Ratio', 'Algebra' and 'decimals'. Please support your child by accessing and practising on TT Rockstars.

Science

Our science topic this term will be 'Healthy Bodies'. We will learn how our heart, digestive, skeletal and muscular systems work. We'll also study the importance of a balanced diet and how to stay healthy.

Art and design

We will explore the artistic world of self-expression and discover how artists like Kandinsky, Picasso and Munch use different techniques to convey emotions and ideas.

Homework

The class have made a fabulous start to weekly homework, which will continue to be set on a Friday and collected the following Wednesday. New weekly spellings will be set each Monday.

PE

Our PE sessions will now be on a Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. The children can continue to wear PE kit for the whole day – preferably dark leggings, tracksuit bottoms or shorts and a white T-shirt.
