**Breakfast Club and After School Club –** Did you know that we operate both a breakfast club and an after school club? These are both available to all parents

should you wish your child to attend.

Breakfast Club begins at 7.45am and costs £2.00. Your child will receive a breakfast of bagel, cereals with the opportunity to take part in a range of well planned activities.



After School Club begins at 3.15pm and ends at 5.00pm. Each sessions costs £5.00. The club has recently introduced new indoor and outdoor activities. The children are provided with healthy snacks. It is a great environment for the children to mix across all year groups, helping them to develop their social skills by playing, sharing and learning new skills together.

How do I book my child onto either Breakfast Club or After School Club? Book on your Teachers to Parents/School Money app or contact the school office and they will be happy to help you.

<u>What is bullying?</u> Bullying is defined as deliberately hurtful behaviour by an individual or a group of individuals, repeated over a period of time, where it is difficult

for those being bullied to defend



The school defines bullying using the acronym STOP:

S = Several

themselves.

- T = Times
- O = On
- P = Purpose

The three main types of bullying are:

• Physical (hitting, kicking, theft)

• Verbal (name calling, racist remarks or comments which relate to any personal characteristics including gender and ethnicity)

• Indirect (spreading rumours, excluding someone from social groups, or increasingly via 'cyber' bullying through new and emerging technology).

At Marlborough Primary children are encouraged to report bullying in school to a teacher or staff member.

<u>Safeguarding</u> - If you have any concerns or worries about your child or any child in school, you can talk to our Safeguarding Team.

Our team is made up of three staff (Mr. Dore, Mrs. Perez and Mrs. Green). They can be easily identified around school as they wear a yellow lanyard so they stand out from other staff.



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Our doors are always open and we are here to help and support all our children and families – please do contact us if you have any concerns or worries.

## Planting our Micro Forest -

On Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March a charity called Societree and Active Devon are coming in to school to plant 400 trees for our new micro forest.
