## Ingredients

1 fruit loaf slice

Chocolate spread

2 banana slices

2 blueberries

2 apple slices

1 strawberry slice

## Equipment

Toaster

Plate

Knife

## Method

- Lightly toast the slice of fruit loaf.
- Once cooled slightly, spread on the chocolate spread.
- Carefully place the banana onto the chocolate spread. Use them to make two big eyes.
- 4. Put a dab of chocolate spread onto each blueberry and place them in the centre of each slice of banana, to complete the eye.
- 5. Place the strawberry below the eyes, in the centre of the toast, to make the beak.
- Use the slices of apple to make the wings
  Place them at an angle on either side of
  the toast, with the curved edges facing
  each other.
