Children investigate the properties of materials and begin to recognise that a material's properties defines its use	cotton wool, compost and one other material. They should also place one more seed in an empty pot.	How wild is the wind? Working in pairs, children get familiar with compass directions drawn on the playground. They then try to catch wind in plastic carrier bags and assess which direction it is coming from and blowing to. Children also measure how far the plastic bag travels in one minute to calculate the force of the wind. They repeat the task every day for a week.	How do boats float? Children think scientifically and discuss the question: 'How do boats float?' They write down their thoughts and record questions that come up in their discussions. Children then place a ball of modelling clay into a bowl of water and watch to see if it floats
