Over two days Ofsted inspectors

met with staff, talked to parents, children, governors and Trustees, as well as watching lots of lessons and looking through children's exercise books. In the report Ofsted commented that the school is welcoming and inclusive, noting that children enjoy their time at the school and form good relationships with staff. They commented on our focus on reading, stating "The school ensures that reading is at the centre of the curriculum".
