New Playground Equipment - We are really pleased to



announce that we have purchased lots of lovely play equipment for the children to use at lunchtimes. They now have access to bats and balls to play tennis, chalks for drawing on the playground, skittles and hoops. The children are really enjoying having these to play with.

You may not be fully aware of how our lunchtimes work. The children have their lunch in the hall over two sittings. Children in Willows and Maple eat their lunch in the hall from 12.00 until about 12.25pm when they come out. Whilst they are eating children in Sycamore and Beech come out to play. They then swap so that Sycamore and Beech go in to eat from 12.25pm. Having this system means that half the school are out playing at any one time whilst the other half are eating. This enables everyone to have time with the equipment with their friends in a more spacious way.

When the children are on the playground there are at least two of the midday staff and often one of the teaching staff out as well. The lunchtime staff patrol around the playground engaging children in the various activities, making sure that everyone is having a good time.

We have recently opened up the front grassed area which the children are thoroughly enjoying as they can go on the climbing equipment. Just after Easter we had a new buddy bench installed — it is the coloured bench on the main playground. The children know that this can be used if you want to just sit and chat with your friends or if your usual friend is away and you would like someone to play with.

We are really lucky to have a lovely playground which has a number of areas for the children to play in. We want children to use the various areas it is therefore important that the lunchtime staff keep moving around interacting with the children.

Attendance - Our current attendance is 91%. We are below the national expectation of 96%. It is really important that your child(ren) are in school, on time,



every day.

<u>Great News</u> – As a school we are always looking for ways to bring more money in so that we can purchase much needed resources for the children.

We have been awarded a grant for £3,000 to purchase a new sound system for the hall, musical workshops for the children, visits to the interactive dome at the Market Hall and to enable art week to happen. This is really great news and will make such a difference to the curriculum the children are offered.







We also put in a bid for £600 with the National Roman Society and were lucky enough to be successful. We have used the monies to purchase a range of resources to support our study of the Romans.

We were also lucky to receive an additional £300 to contribute to towards our celebrations for the King's Coronation. This has paid for the bunting, flags and some treats for all children. A big thank you to Mrs. Greenwood for putting the application in.





Y6 SATs Week – The children in Y6 will be undertaking their Y6 SATs papers this coming week. These are formal tests and are mandatory for all children in Y6. The SATs test what they have learnt between Y3 and Y6. Once the children have completed the tests they are sent away to be marked externally. We will receive their

results in early July. They will be taking the following tests:

- 1) Punctuation, Vocabulary and Grammar 45 minutes
- 2) Spelling 15 minutes

Wednesday:

1) Reading - 1 hour

Thursday:

- 1) Maths Paper 1 Arthimetic 30 minutes
- 2) Maths Paper 2 Reasoning 40 minutes

Friday:

1) Maths Paper 3 Reasoning – 40 minutes
