
Our Topic

Now that children are settled, we will continue our topic superheroes and we will start teaching our Year 1 children some science and history knowledge throughout this topic. Reception children will use a superhero story as a hook, but they will decide how and what direction their learning will take.


Key stories - We will start the term with the story Supertato by Sue Hendra & Paul Linnet. As usual, we will be informing you when we move to a different story book.

Important Information

Book bags - We aim to change Book Bags once a week. This can happen on any day of the week, for this



including children's comments/progress, in their yellow reading record. For children in Year 1, please let us know how they are doing with their reading by writing in the reading record. Please listen to your child read the same story several times so they gain fluency.
