Our topic this term is called Mud, Mess and Mixtures. We will be investigating mixing colours using different paints and media, The

children will be creating weird and wonderful mixtures using a variety of products and investigating which products can make the biggest bubbles. Later in the term, we will be researching an artist called Carl Warner - he creates pieces of art using fruit, vegetables and food items; we will be creating our own of artwork based on Carl Warner's ideas.

At the end of this term, we will be inviting the parents to come and view the children's artwork by creating an art exhibition. I will inform you of the date closer to the end of term via Class Dojo.



PE will be on a Friday afternoon - Little Oaks will be joining the Year 3 class for this session - this is the same group they joined for PE last year. As stated in the newsletter by Miss Summers, children will need to come to school in their PE kit on a Friday - this will be reviewed at

the end of September.



I have reviewed the activities we completed in Little Oaks last year and have decided to add a cookery session into our weekly timetable. This term we will be looking at different recipes, how to use weighing equipment and creating some simple recipes to practise our cutting and mixing skills.



This term, we would like to continue with our outdoor learning and craft activities as well as introducing our weekly cookery sessions. We would like to ask for a contribution of £5.00 per child - this will be for this half term. This can be payable as £5.00 or £1.00 per week.

This term, we will be issuing the children with reading books and reading records. Children should be reading at home at least twice a week. This could be learning phonic words which will be sent home or reading their book. Remember to ask the children about the books we are reading in class.
