<u>Reading Masters -</u> We are introducing a new reading comprehension programme called Reading Masters. This will take place every day, giving the children access to a wide range of quality texts, enabling focussed discussion and ensuring the children have the skills and confidence to answer a range of comprehension questions accurately.

<u>Attendance</u> - Our current attendance is 95%. We are <u>below</u> the national expectation of 96%. It is really important that your child(ren) are in school, on time, every day.

Did you know that not being in school can affect your child's learning and progress not just this year, but until they leave school!
